Sea Stars live in the sea and can be found in tide pools. Some Sea Stars have 5 arms but some like Sun Stars have up to 40 arms! A Sea Star can break off its arm if in danger and grow a new one but it takes up to one year. When they capture prey, they have tiny suction cups to grab a hold of their food. Then their stomach exits their mouth to digest the food, and reenters the body when they're done eating. They love to eat shellfish and snails. They have no brain and no blood. Sea Stars can live for up to 35 years.
